



YOU WILL REQUIRE A REPAIR KIT WHICH INCLUDES: Collector Pressure Sleeves Joining Barbs Grommets

## **Supreme Instructions:** Repairing a Hole in the Collector



**STEP 1:** Squeeze the collector upward to expose the hole in the collector.



**STEP 3:** Expose approximately 5cm of collector around the hole.



**STEP 5:** Place a pressure sleeve on either side of the collector.



**STEP 7:** Push the other side of the collector over the joining barb to connect the two sides.



**STEP 2:** Cut the webbing between the tubes on either side of the hole.



**STEP 4:** Cut the collector on either side of the hole to remove it.



**STEP 6:** Push a joining barb onto one of the sides. Using a lubricant will make this easier.
